Kindergarten Application 2018

The school is now accepting applications for Kindergarten placements for the 2018 school year. Application packages will be available from the office from Monday 29th May. Prospective applicants will need to provide Birth Certificate, Immunisation records and proof of residence. Applications will be accepted up until Friday 21st July (Week 1 of Term 3). Please be aware that early return of the application form does not guarantee a placement for 2018.

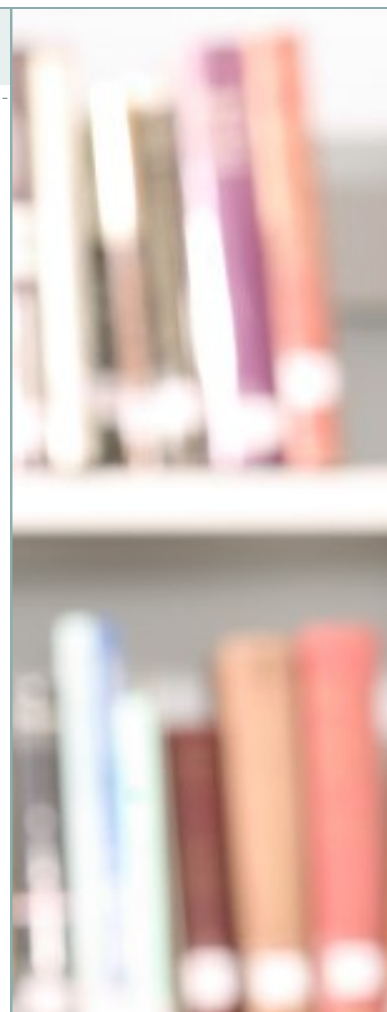
Wet weather

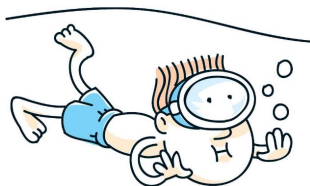
