Evidence based studies positivity show engagement to culture improves outcomes in life. Where is the cultural classes and I don't mean language but cultural as in connection to land and lore.
Girls bullying girls. I know there has been some classes to work through the issue. I think it needs to be a priority. I watch how nasty some of the girls are and it's not the way. I think maybe having a 15 class with all the girls from year 4 to 6 mixed ages and do some friendship building. Coming from another country I find the education my daughter is receiving in kindergarten to be outstanding, and I look forward to the years to come.
Kids in year 1 to 4 arnt given 1st 2nd 3rd in sports carnival , I believe these kids need to be shown that if they win a race they get something different to the other kids ... we teach our kids to do there very best and try there hardest and every school subject but only reward the academics not sports
My child has a medical condition and the And management of her with me has been outstanding at all levels. The school is an absolute role model in this area
I feel like we should go back to receiving newsletters by mail. When busy and I get notification that an update has happened or a new newsletter has been uploaded I don't have a chance to read it, then I forget to check it later. And then my children miss out on important events due to this. I feel newsletters by paper was a lot better, because you could stick it somewhere you would see it
More recess and lunch time. How about some Aboriginal stuff too
No, we are very happy with the school and the way it is operating. Fabulous Principal , awesome teachers and great support staff in admin and classrooms. We feel very lucky to be part of the DPS Community.
Please can the planter boxes be planted in the early learning area, some parents would even be happy to donate the flowers/plants etc :)
The no play before school is a bit ridiculous. Get parents to sign a waiver at the start of each year to say they accept responsibility for before and after school play. There is not enough Aboriginal cultural activities. It is important to be an Australian and to Aboriginal kids too.
Toilets to be cleaned. Not good smell.
PBS program is excellent although some teachers clearly aren't following it and tend to be too negative and pedantic. Need to be more accomodating to the learning needs of boys and less focussed on ticking boxes.
I dislike the running of our schools carnivals, kids need to be rewarded for coming 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Kids arnt all equal like the school pushes it to be. Reward the kids that do there best and actually win, and do well it will make all other kids try that bit harder next time to maybe get a placing aswell. We teach our kids to do there very best but thry arnt rewarded for it
I do get disappointed with the running of our carnivals ect there should be place ribbons given to reward the ones that really try hard. And the fact our school doesn't take the kids out on excursions is a let down aswell.
I would love to see more play based learning happening in the pre-primary classrooms and less desk top activities and worksheets. It would be wonderful to see more dramatic play areas both inside and outside the classroom and more sensory play activities.
I'd also love to see a nature type play area in the pre-primary and kindy playground. A mud kitchen for messy play would be fantastic also!
More support in classes to help teachers with the wide range of abilities/behaviours. My year 4 child is fine but my other child struggles and is left behind as they are not the weakest and behave well so go unnoticed. It's a crime that the year 3 classes have no support. The students are 7/8/9 and are still learning fundamentals which if not learned well effect their success in later years.
Teachers are great but having too much students behaviour to deal with so it hard to pass on knowledge that the students need. Toilets should be cleaner.

Teachers should inform parents when child area having difficulty understanding concepts. Main areas numeracy and literacy. Having to ask my child and explain concepts. Difficult to arrange catch up time that suits teachers and parents secondary to work and family lives.

We love the reading program & the iPad draw for students who reach 200 nights. As an added incentive it would be great if the students who reach 300 nights got a bonus entry.

Celebration of World Teacher Day. Students come to school dressed as their favourite teacher and the teachers do the assembly for the kids. Teachers do a song or skit etc.
